

# Scenario

## 12. Just let sleepin' horses lie

*You step out of the house to check on your horse that is lying on his knees at the back of the corral. You throw your loop on him and start to walk up when you see a hand on his mane holding him down and a double barrel shotgun sticking up over his withers. . . .*

### Scenario Procedure

The shooter starts at the corral gate with rope in hand. At the buzzer, the shooter pulls the rope, jerking down the horse and exposing the pistol targets. Shooter engages the pistol targets in this order 3, 2, 1, 2, 3.

The shooter then drops the rope and goes to the water trough, takes up his shotgun and engages the three shotgun targets in this order 3, 2, 1, 2, 3.

The shooter goes to the house and takes the rifle from the doorway. He engages the four rifle targets, double tapping from right to left.

*Safety is the first consideration regarding all scenarios. The scenario may need to be modified based upon shooters or range capabilities. The magazine does not accept liability for any accidents, injuries or other difficulties arising out of the use of its scenarios. Range officers and participants should always check out their scenarios for safe conditions before proceeding to shoot.*

**pistol** holstered, loaded with five, hammer on an empty chamber



**shotgun** empty, staged at the trough, at least six shells in the trough



**rifle** loaded with eight, chamber empty, staged in the house
